Spring has finally arrived, and summer is right around the corner. As our customer base continues to grow, we must work together to preserve the limited water supply we have. By conserving water voluntarily, we can help avoid mandatory restrictions.

You can review or download the full Water Conservation and Drought Contingency Plans on our official website at www.bvbsud.com. Section 5 of the plan includes a full list of non-essential water use activities. Additional penalties for non-compliance have been added to the Drought Contingency Plan. We will notify customers of any water shortage stages through radio, newspapers, monthly bills, and our official website, as well as through text and/or email alerts for those who sign up. To keep up with what's happening in our water district, we encourage you to sign up for text and/or email alerts by visiting www.bvbsud.com. If you have any questions about the alerts, please feel free to call our office at 972/937-1212.

Stage 1 which runs from March 1 through September 30, asks that you voluntarily conserve water and limit watering to the hours between 8pm and 8am.

Stage 2 requires odd-numbered addresses to water on Mondays and Wednesdays, while evennumbered addresses can water on Tuesdays and Thursdays. We suggest setting your automatic sprinklers to these days for your regular schedule all the time. Hand-held hoses with a positive pressure shut-off valve, faucet-filled buckets, and 5-gallon watering cans are allowed at any time.

Stage 3, watering goes down to once a week, with odd-numbered addresses watering on Mondays and even-numbered addresses watering on Thursdays. The same watering methods are allowed.

Stage 4, all outdoor watering must stop.

Construction Update:

The first woodbine well is underway and expected to be completed by the end of 2024. The second woodbine well is behind schedule due to the test hole not meeting production standards. We have secured a new location and engineering has started.
